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BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PLAN OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) strives to help make Florida the nation's top performing economy and be recognized as the world's best place to do business. Minority business is a very important and integral part of Florida's economy. DEO spent approximately \$11.4 million with certified and non-certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses in FY 2012/2013. As we continue to make strides forward, under the leadership and direction of the Executive Director, Jesse Panuccio, DEO's goal is to promote and support the active participation of minority, veteran and women-owned businesses utilizing assistance from the Division of Strategic Business Development, Workforce Services, Community Development, Finance & Administration and other Joint Partnership alliances.

In keeping with the intent of the diversity in contracting and procurement, DEO will continue to give opportunity to minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses to participate in DEO's solicitations. DEO will send copies of its procurement opportunities to the Office of Supplier Diversity for publication in DEO's OSD Link, a tool the Office of Supplier Diversity uses to communicate with certified vendors on a monthly basis. DEO will encourage all DEO staff involved in the purchasing of goods and services to obtain quotes from certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses, regardless of the dollar amount. To help increase minority spending, DEO's Purchasing and Contracting Procedures Manual suggest obtaining at least one quote from a certified minority vendor. This process helps ensure that the program area is doing their due diligence in seeking minority vendors and also allows the Purchasing Office to assist the program areas prior to locating certified minority businesses that will help fill their specific needs.

DEO adheres to the provisions established in Chapter 287, Florida Statutes, Chapter 60A, Florida Administrative Code rules of the Division of State Purchasing, Department of Management Services and existing DEO procurement policies and procedures that have been established for fair and equitable opportunities in public procurement processes.

VISION STATEMENT

DEO promotes economic opportunities for all Floridians through successful workforce, community, and economic development strategies.

BUSINESS PARTICIPATION MISSION STATEMENT

DEO is committed to promoting diversity in our contracting and procurement methods and will strive to increase participation among certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses through educational and outreach initiatives to successfully ensure maximum opportunity and participation in the economic life of the State of Florida.

BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

DEO will implement activities that provide an ongoing value to the Program as well as identifying additional initiatives that will further the directives and philosophies of the One Florida Initiative and the Office of Supplier Diversity.

The Program will consist of the following components:

- Staffing and Outreach Activities – DEO maintains a Career Service position that is responsible for oversight of the initiatives identified in the participation plan.
- Programs to Educate Business Owners – These initiatives ensure that businesses are informed and instructed in various processes necessary to successfully complete and participate in procurement opportunities.
- Internal Steps for Implementation of Plan – These activities ensure that businesses are afforded opportunities to fair and open competition and participation in procurement activities regardless of value.
- Reviews and Reporting – This activity will systematically measure initiative effectiveness by identifying successes and opportunities.
- New Initiatives to Enhance Minority Participation – These activities will educate businesses on the tools available to effectively respond to procurement opportunities provided by federal, state or local governments.

DEO CMBE STAFFING AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

The Chief of General Services, DEO's Purchasing Manager, and staff are integral to the overall success of DEO's Minority, Veterans, and Women-owned Business Participation Program. The Chief of General Services will ensure that internal goals established for the program are met and that the initiatives outlined in this plan are implemented and followed.

DEO's Minority Business Enterprise Coordinator is Lori Jones. She will ensure DEO attendance at all required functions related to the minority business program and will track DEO expenditures with certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses on a monthly basis. She will also facilitate all certified minority, veterans, and women-owned business outreach activities and trains requestors that require commodities or services on how to locate certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses using the Office of Supplier Diversity's website to obtain quotes. To improve certified minority, veterans, and women-owned business participation, DEO will:

- Obtain quarterly expenditure reports from the Division of Strategic Business Development and Partnerships that document their utilization of, minority, veterans and women-owned businesses for third tier spending. DEO will also update its certified minority, veterans, and women-owned business listing and will share this information with the Division of Strategic Business Development and Partnerships.
- Hold minority meetings within DEO to encourage DEO's program areas to obtain quotes from minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses when possible. These meetings also will serve as a forum where monthly, quarterly and yearly expenditure data is shared and new minority vendors are introduced.
- Show its commitment in increasing DEO's CMBE expenditures by inviting CMBE vendors to DEO's minority meetings. This provides DEO's program areas with valuable information regarding opportunities with minority vendors and will give the vendors a chance to meet with representatives from the respective divisions.
- Inform the Office of Supplier Diversity of solicitation opportunities at DEO.
- Encourage all contractors, where the contract allows for the use of sub-contractors, to utilize, minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses for their second-tier spending. DEO will capture subcontracting expenditures resulting from formal solicitations and other awarded contracts on the DEO "Exhibit II Contractor Monthly MBE VBE Report FY1314" form. Relevant language has been incorporated into our contract documents that will capture minority subcontracting spending.
- Submit monthly the names of eligible non-certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses to the Office of Supplier Diversity to assist them in the certification process using the top ten non-certified vendors with the largest expenditure amount. We will be proactive in identifying non-certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses and communicate the benefits of certification.
- Seek out and attend local, regional and statewide business trade fairs that facilitate personal interaction with minority, veterans and women-owned vendors such as the Matchmaker Conference scheduled annually in Orlando. This will allow DEO to establish new business relationships with various minority and women-owned businesses and increase awareness of DEO commodities and contractual service needs.
- Attend and participate in the monthly diversity meetings facilitated by the Office of Supplier Diversity.
- Educate requester's within DEO and the Partnerships on how to utilize the Office of Supplier Diversity's On-Line Directory real time electronic Certified Minority Business database to identify and obtain quotes.
- Remind cardholders of the State of Florida VISA Purchasing Card of the need to use minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses in all procurement activities.

PROGRAMS TO EDUCATE BUSINESS OWNERS, INCLUDING MINORITY, VETERANS, AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES

To educate business owners about the various processes DEO will use to reach businesses, we will participate in the below listed events wherein we can provide information on DEO and its commitment to minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses.

- DEO will sponsor and attend the Office of Supplier Diversity's regional trade fairs and annual Matchmaker Conference.
- DEO will participate in one-on-one sessions with minority vendors to educate the vendors on the types of commodities and services that DEO procures.
- DEO will participate in trade fairs and regional workshops held by the Office of Supplier Diversity.
- DEO will identify non-certified, minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses and communicate to them the benefits of becoming a certified minority business.
- DEO's procurement staff will convey its commitment to increase its procurements with minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses at pre-bid conferences and negotiation meetings.
- DEO will post its 90 day spending plan on its website which will include appropriate DEO personnel contact information.
- DEO will provide useful tools and resources on its internet site, such as a link to the Florida Procurement Technical Assistance Center Program (PTAC). PTAC provides counseling free of charge to businesses educating them on government procurement policies, instructions on bid/proposal preparation, contract administration and marketing.
- DEO will maintain an internet/intranet website directed at promoting and educating DEO employees on the importance of diversity in the procurement program and process.
- Staff of DEO's Procurement and Purchasing section will emphasize the inclusion of minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses for all procurement opportunities made available by DEO.

NEW & INTERNAL STEPS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF PLAN

To further DEO's commitment to the utilization of minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses, DEO will take the below listed steps to implement the plan internally. In addition to the steps listed, DEO will look for new ways to increase utilization of minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses in the daily acquisition of commodities and services by:

- Encourage all DEO staff involved in the purchasing of commodities and contractual services to obtain quotes from certified minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses, regardless of the dollar amount.
- Encourage DEO contracted vendors to provide subcontracting opportunities to minority, veterans, and women-owned businesses.
- Identify miscoded expenditures in FLAIR. This will allow DEO to capture minority dollars from minority vendors not previously captured.
- Conduct Certified Minority, Veterans, and Women-owned business meetings to encourage diligence in pursuit of equity in contracting and to inform team members of new minority vendors that have been discovered within the previous month. In addition to conducting the monthly meetings, DEO will introduce and invite minority vendors to these meetings.
- Attend and support all outreach efforts at conferences, workshops, exhibits and tradeshows such as the Matchmaker Conferences. When involved in these activities, DEO will distribute a brochure (Exhibit I) to vendors that contains the contact information of each Purchasing staff member and a listing of the goods and service used by DEO on a regular basis. The brochure will also give the vendors an overview of DEO and how it operates.
- Provide DEO training to educate, promote and increase diversity in all DEO procurement and contracting processes.
- Post DEO's Business Participation Plan on DEO internet site.
- Post the Contractor Monthly Minority Business Enterprise Veteran (MBE/VBE) Report to DEO's intranet site (Exhibit II). This reporting form will assist Program Areas and DEO contracted vendors with capturing minority 2nd tier subcontractor expenditures on a monthly basis.
- The purchasing and contract administration unit will continue to update the purchasing policies and procedures manual to include accurate information on minority, veteran, and women-owned business enterprises.

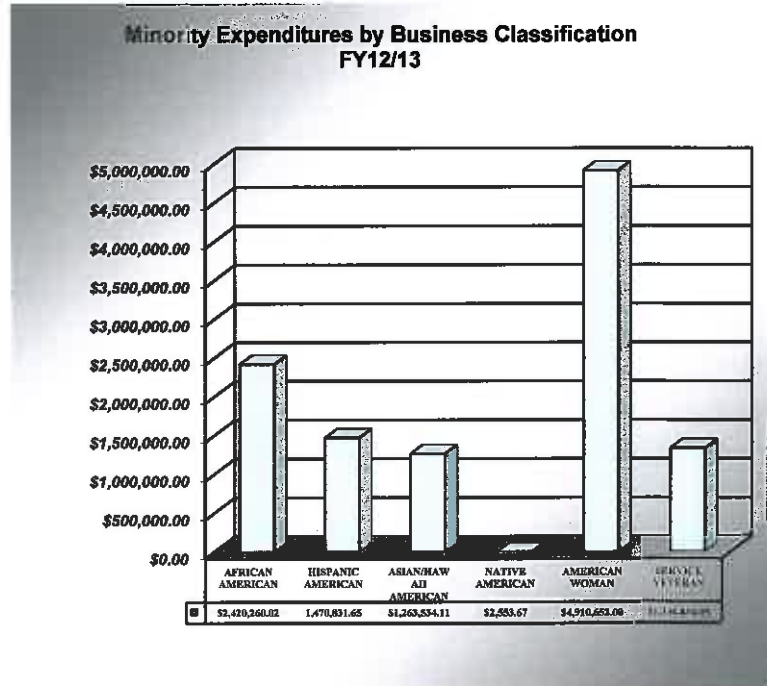
