Suggested Audience:

Data Warehouse Users

Description of Issue:

On July 19, 2008, we will implement several changes to the data warehouse environment.

Summary of Enhancements:

1. The following fields will be modified as follows:
 - a. OMIT_411_DIR (Omit from 411 Directory) field will be removed from the data warehouse views. The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Employee_Active
 - Pos_Supervisor_Active
 - b. BUSINESS_PHONE (Business Phone Number) field will be renamed to 411_Phone_Number. The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Position_Active
 - Pos_Supervisor_Active
 - c. SUNCOM_PHONE (Suncom phone number) field will be removed from the data warehouse views. The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Employee_Active
 - Position_Active
 - Pos_Supervisor_Active
 - d. BUSINESS_PHONE_EXT (Business Phone Extension) will be renamed to 411_Phone_Number_Ext in the data warehouse views. The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Position_Active
 - Pos_Supervisor_Active

- e. PAGER_NUM (Pager Number) will be renamed to Alternate_Phone_Number in the data warehouse views. **Any existing data in this field will need to be manually deleted from People First.** The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Positive_Active
 - f. PAGER_ID (Pager ID) will be renamed to Alternate_Phone_Number_Ext in the data warehouse views. **Any existing data in this field will need to be manually deleted from People First.** The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Positive_Active
- Note: The PAGER_ID field will be removed from the Address Active view.
- g. FAX_SUNCOM (Fax Suncom phone number) will be removed from the data warehouse views. The affected views are:
 - DWSOF_All
 - DWSOF_All_Active
 - DWSOF_All_Inactive
 - Position_Active

2. EMAIL_ADDRESS and EMAIL_ADDRESS_PUBL_IND – E-mail address and E-mail Address Publish Indicator fields will be available in the Employee_Active, DWSOF_All and DWSOF_All_Active views.

The E-Mail address and E-Mail Publish Indicator fields will be removed from the Address Active view effective August 2, 2008. This will provide time for agencies to modify any internal programs or extracts.

3. End Dates – The following views will have enhancements made to ensure that valid data is presented in the data warehouse view:
 - a. Certification Active - This view will be renamed to Certification View. It will display current and historical certification for an employee. It will match the data in the front end of People First.
 - b. Drivers License Active – The data in this view will be truncated and reloaded from People First. Effective July 19, 2008, agencies should enter the driver's license information without dashes.
 - c. Recurring Pay Additive – A new view will be created to ensure that pay additive end dates will match the data stored in People First.
 - d. Position Active View – A new field will be added to this view. It is the FLSA work week. This will allow agencies to accurately identify the work week of their employees.
 - e. Tuition Waiver Active – This will be renamed to Tuition Waiver. It will display current and historical tuition waiver data for an employee. It will match the data in the front end of People First.

4. Employee_411 View – A new view will be available for reporting purposes. This view will contain the employee work contact information. It is the same information that is being used to populate the 411 Directory (http://411.myflorida.com/apps/411/tel411.public_411) each night. If a data warehouse user has access to confidential information they will retrieve all available records. Employees without access to confidential information will not be able to retrieve all available records.
5. Planned Work Time Active – This view will be removed.
6. Pay Additive Active – No change will be made to this view. It will continue to store pay additive information by pay period. It is important to remember that pay additive information is overwritten each pay period in this view.

How Does This Impact Me?

1. Internal agency programs will need to be reviewed to see if these changes affect them. If so, those programs will need to be modified.
2. Impromptu reports will need to be modified (remove fields or rename fields).

What Do I Need To Do?

1. Notify your data warehouse users and information technology staff of these upcoming changes. They will need to identify their internal programs that contain these data fields and modify them.
2. You may test your internal programs using the test queue beginning Friday, June 6, 2008. The data in the test environment is scrambled and the number of available records is limited; for example, agencies with 30,000 records may only have 15,000 records in the test environment.
3. A new data warehouse catalog will be made available by close of business July 21, 2008. You will need to download this catalog.
