Release Item	Description
Create Pre-1973 Sick Leave Balance Adjustment Leave Type	Create a leave balance adjustment leave type on the Leave Balance Adjustment screen titled "Pre-1973 Sick Leave Adjustment." When a leave balance adjustment is created using this leave type, the number of hours adjusted will be applied to the employee's pre-1973 sick leave balance. In addition, the employee's Leave Balance Overview screen will show the adjustment under the "Pre-1973 Sick Leave Balance column."
Increase the Career Service Annual Leave Rollover Cap for DMA, FSDB, FPC	Increase the Career Service Annual Leave rollover cap for Department of Military Affairs, Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind and Florida Parole Commission to 360 hours effective December 1, 2008.
SES/SMS Proration of Annual Leave	In the 12/08/07 (A-10 #58 – SES/SMS Proration of Annual Leave) release, SES/SMS employees who termed or moved to Career Service were to have their leave prorated by the system. This functionality works for employees hired before 12/08/07. For employees hired into SES/SMS after 12/08/07, the proration functionality does not work correctly when these individuals leave the SES/SMS pay plan. This release will fix this defect.
Rescheduled for later release Security Indicator Warning Message When Acting Upon PAR	Some agencies have reported receiving a warning message stating that the employee's sworn law enforcement officer security indicator will be removed when acting upon a PAR, even though the indicator was never marked for the employee. This release will fix this defect from the 07/19/08 Release (A-10 #60 – Security Indicators on Employee and Position Records) and agencies will no longer receive this message unless it is valid for the employee.
Competitive Area Differential (CAD) Records Available in the Data Warehouse Table	Currently, the Competitive Area Differential (CAD) - Wage Type 2014 records are not captured in the Recurring Pay additive view. This release will correct this issue.
DOT Time and Attendance Interface	This release will correct the defect with the Department of Transportation's time and attendance interface. Currently, when on-call and leave are present on the same timesheet day, the system drops the records, which requires manual intervention by the agency.
