

**System Enhancement 63: 10/28/2010 Release Summary – Talent Management**

Release Item	Description
<p><b>Applicant Adobe Settings – Present Message to Applicants That do not Have the Proper Adobe Settings</b></p>	<p>In order to successfully apply, applicants must have the appropriate Adobe settings. If the proper settings are not enabled at the point of applying or updating the application, a message will be presented to the user advising them how to update the required settings.</p> <p>Required settings include allowing adobe documents to open in the browser as well as having Java Script enabled for Adobe Reader.</p>
<p><b>Updates to Bulk Printing of Applications - Eliminate the Red X Issue as Well as Allow the Save Option</b></p>	<p>With this release, the red x issue that agencies have been experiencing when bulk printing is being eliminated. Now, if the “select all” function is used to bulk print applications, all applications selected can be printed. If more than 100 applicants are chosen, the print queue will contain multiple print selections with up to 100 applications per selection. The user must print the first 100 applications; then select the “next” button to print the remaining applications (or next batch) that was selected.</p> <p>Users will now have the ability to save applications that are requested to be bulk printed. This save feature will be available when the applications are requested for bulk printing.</p>
<p><b>Users Logging in with a MAC Computer, Using Firefox Browser</b></p>	<p>The staffing site does not support users logging in with a MAC computer, using a Firefox browser. If an attempt is made to update an application or apply for a vacancy with this combination, the user will be presented with a message advising them to use the Safari browser.</p>
<p><b>Applicants Applying After They are Manually Added to the Requisition</b></p>	<p>Applicants will now be able to apply electronically for a vacancy even if they have previously faxed their application for the same vacancy. If this occurs, both applications will be stored in the applicant’s profile. The faxed application will be stored in the additional attachments section and the electronic application will be stored in the employment application section. This enhancement will also allow applicants to complete qualifying questions online.</p>
