Release Item	Description
<p>Timesheet – Change Warning Messages to Informational Messages</p>	<p>Several warning messages within the timesheet are being changed to informational messages. Once the “save” or “submit for approval” button is selected, the informational message will be presented and the hours entered on the timesheet will be saved/submitted.</p> <p>Warning messages will still be presented when using administrative leave and workers’ compensation hours types if the hours used exceed what is allowed per the rule.</p>
<p>Leave Accruals – Regular Compensation Accruals for Career Service Excluded Employees</p>	<p>The current defect for career service excluded employees not receiving the correct regular comp accruals during the pay period of new hire is being corrected. The current defect for career service employees who move from included to excluded in a pay period not receiving the correct regular comp accruals is also being corrected.</p> <p>This change is being applied retroactively in the system to correct employee’s regular comp accruals if needed. DMS will provide agencies with a list of impacted employees after the release to production.</p>
<p>Personal Holiday – Using a Personal Holiday During a Week that Crosses Fiscal Years</p>	<p>The current defect involving the use of both personal holidays (prior and current) during the fiscal year crossover week is being corrected.</p> <p>Prior to this release, if an employee tried to use both personal holidays during the fiscal year crossover week they would be presented with an error message and could only use one personal holiday.</p>
<p>Timesheet Approval – Approving Mid Period Timesheets When Changing Managers</p>	<p>The current defect where a manager cannot approve a timesheet for a new direct report that moved from another manager in the middle of the pay period is being corrected.</p>
<p>Supplemental Pay Screen – Next Available Payroll Default</p>	<p>The current defect with the next available supplemental payroll not defaulting on the “Supplemental Pay” screen when the employee has a future dated termination action is being corrected.</p>
